

Star Flyer will spend much of the summer sailing through France and Italy – a region as renowned for its food as its scenery. Star Clipper sails the storied and history-filled coasts of Greece and Turkey as it calls on ports in the Eastern Mediterranean.

All three ships will also sail the Transatlantic Crossing – a popular itinerary that sells out quickly – and we look forward to welcoming new travellers and loyalty guests on one of these incredible journeys.

No matter what part of the globe you choose to visit, we promise you a unique, intimate cruise experience not possible on a larger ship. While on board, embrace the nautical life and help raise the sails and learn to tie a proper knot. Twin sisters *Star Clipper* and *Star Flyer* are true Clipper Ships reflecting their proud heritage in every inch of their polished brass and gleaming charm. They are modern small ships in every way, created for adventure-loving passengers looking for the tradition and romance of the legendary era of sailing ships but with the comforts and amenities of the present day. As identical twins, they are both 379 feet long and each carry 166 guests in pampered comfort, over 36,000 square feet of sails. Sixteen sails billowing in the wind.

NAUTICAL HERITAGE

Each ship offers spacious Accommodation and expansive teak decks with ample space for walking and relaxation. In fact, you'll find that these ships offer more outdoor space per passenger than most conventional cruise ships.



You may think you know the Caribbean, but visiting this gorgeous part of the globe on board one of our tall ships allows for a completely fresh perspective.



On Star Flyer, you'll have a choice of itineraries visiting either the Leeward Islands, sailing south, or the Treasure Islands, sailing west, departing from beautiful St. Maarten. Royal Clipper sails from Barbados, heading north to the Windward Islands or west to the Grenadine Islands.

The opportunity to attend special events while in the Caribbean make these sailings all the more appealing. *Royal Clipper* calls on exotic Martinique during their Mardi Gras festivities, allowing guests to experience the magic of this island's French-meets-Caribbean culture. Serious sailing fans will want to check out our Super Yacht itineraries on *Star Flyer*, which put guests in St. Bart during the popular Bucket Regatta.

Central America



With an expansive rain forest and beaches flanking both the Pacific Ocean and Caribbean Sea, Costa Rica is one of the most biodiverse countries in the world.

In fact, this small country boasts nearly half a million species of plants and animals inhabiting less than 20,000 square miles. The lush natural environment translates to plenty of opportunities for unique exploration, including kayaking through the fascinating mangrove forests, getting a birds-eye view on a canopy forest tour, or simply combing the pristine beaches for shells.


On *Star Clipper*, a pair of seven-day sailings round trip out of Puerto Caldera call on favorite Costa Rican towns as well as ports in Panama and Nicaragua, depending on which itinerary you choose. The port town of Quepos, located near the magnificent Manuel Antonio National Park, allows guests the opportunities to encounter monkeys, sloths, and nearly 450 species of birds that call the park home.

The beaches on idyllic Isla Tortuga are ideal for snorkelling or taking a dip in the turquoise waters. In San Juan del Sur, Nicaragua, the beaches offer incredible surfing, and guests can glimpse the

Mirador del Cristo de la Misericordia statue at the northern end of the bay—one of the largest statues of Jesus in the world.

Six sailings between Balboa, Panama, and Costa Rica offer a deeper dive into this intriguing country. The uninhabited Isla Iguana is a wildlife reserve located on Panama's Pacific coast where guests can watch the colorful frigate birds fly in formation and visit expansive coral reefs containing more than 500 marine species including rare olive ridley sea turtles. Travelers looking for the "deserted island" moment will love Isla San Jose in the Pearl Islands, a 44 kilometer slice of paradise.

With more than 800 miles of coastline and spectacular coral reefs, Costa Rica offers incredible opportunities for snorkelling. Star Clippers' water sports program allows guests to borrow snorkelling equipment for the duration of the sailing, which they can use to their hearts content.

Port Charges: Must be added to all rates and are subject to change at any time. No discounts apply.

Single Supplement Rates: A single supplement fare is available at 150% of the published cruise tariff for categories 2-6 selected in the season in which the passengers are travelling. It is available at 200% for category 1 cabins, Deluxe Suites and the Owner's Cabin or Suites. Single space is capacity controlled.

Guaranteed Single: A guaranteed single rate is a special rate for a passenger wishing to sail alone in the cabin. This is a fixed rate whereby Star Clippers will choose and assign the cabin from any cabin category upon embarkation. This rate is based on availability and is capacity controlled. No other discount is applicable on this rate.

Cruise Documents: When boarding, all passengers must have their cruise ticket, passport, that is valid at least six months beyond the end of your cruise, or ID and visas (where necessary). We recommend that travel documents be kept with hand luggage.

Your cabin: Your cabin is ingeniously designed for comfort and efficiency, with private bathroom, air-conditioning, region TV/free multimedia DVD player, hairdryer and is equipped with a private safe located inside the closet. Operating instructions are posted on the inside of the closet door. Because each passenger is responsible for items kept in his/her stateroom, it is recommended to place items of special value in the complimentary safe. All cabins are non-smoking.

Personal funds and credit cards: Each passenger will receive a personalised identification card that will be used to charge services and products provided onboard the ship. The identification cards must be presented each time a passenger boards the ship. Passengers are advised to carry their identification card with them at all times. Each account can be settled in cash Euros or credit cards on the final day of the cruise. The following credit cards are accepted on board: Visa, Mastercard, American Express.

Electrical Appliances: Star Clipper and Star Flyer ships provide passengers with 110-volt (American and European plugs). Royal Clipper has 220-volt (European plug). Each cabin is equipped with 2 hairdryers.

Telephone communications: Cabins are equipped with a direct dial telephone that passengers can use while at sea. On Royal Clipper, all calls will be billed to their onboard account. On Star Clipper and Star Flyer a credit card may be used directly. Should someone wish to contact a passenger at sea, they may do so by calling the Star Clippers' office and the information will be forwarded to the ship. Please note that telephone and internet communication during Ocean Crossings cannot be guaranteed. Wifi information is available from the Purser's office. Internet rates will be charged to passengers' onboard account.

E-mails: E-mail and WI-FI services are available onboard wherever technically possible (depending on Satellite connections).

This ensures that where the holiday includes flights, in the unlikely event of insolvency of the licence holder, the CAA will arrange to refund money paid for an advance Booking and ensure that passengers are not stranded abroad. 3.2 We will provide you with the services you have bought (or a suitable alternative). In some cases, where we are not able to do so for reasons of insolvency, an alternative ATOL holder may provide you with the services you have bought or a suitable alternative (at no extra cost to you). You agree to accept that in those circumstances the alternative ATOL holder will perform those obligations and you agree to pay any money outstanding to be paid by you under your contract to that alternative ATOL holder, in which case you will be entitled to claim under the ATOL scheme (or your credit card issuer where applicable).
3.3 From 1st October 2012 you will receive an ATOL certificate for all ATOL protected flight or flight inclusive holidays booked with FOT trading as Star Clippers. This lists the flight, accommodation, car hire and or other services that are financially protected, where information is provided on what this means for the passenger and who to contact if things go wrong.
3.4 AS a member of ABTA (membership, number V3510), FOT

Deposit, Alterations and Final Payment

Holiday Price, Other Charges and Price Guarantee
5.1 Published prices are based on operating costs and other factors at the date of preparation. Published prices may be revised upwards or downwards at any time. Prices should be checked at the time of Booking and may be subject to variation until the Booking is accepted by FOT.
5.2 Once a Booking has been accepted by FOT, no increase or decrease in the price will be made except where stated in 5.3 below.

Conduct, Safety and Security
8.1 At any time during the holiday FOT or any other party acting as operator or otherwise involved in the supply of services under this contract may take such steps as are deemed necessary to prevent any risk to the health, safety, comfort or well-being of any person. In no circumstances shall FOT have any liability for prevention of boarding of any form of transport due to a decision made by any party other than FOT.

9.9 All carriage (by land, air and sea) is subject to the conditions of carriage of the actual operator / carrier. These may limit or exclude liability. Save as otherwise provided in these Conditions, the carriers' conditions of carriage are expressly incorporated into the Contract and are deemed to be expressly accepted by the Passenger at the time of the Booking. Copies of these Conditions are available on request from FOT.

9.10 FOT's liability will not at any time exceed that of any carrier under the carrier's conditions of carriage and/or applicable or incorporated conventions.

Claims

10.1 Any matter which might give rise to a problem, complaint or claim must be notified to the ship or hotel management, airline staff or other relevant supplier of services at the time of the incident. If the matter cannot be rectified immediately FOT must be notified as soon as possible and in any event notice of a claim must be given in writing to FOT within 30 days of the matter arising. Special extra provisions set out below apply to loss, damage or delay to baggage and to claims for illness or injury. Failure to give notice in accordance with these provisions may mean that the matter cannot be properly investigated or rectified and this may affect the passenger's rights.

10.2 In the case of any claim for loss, damage or delay to baggage please note that (1) the passenger must claim against the carrier or carriers responsible for actually performing the carriage where the loss or damage is or becomes apparent and in any event within 15 days from the date of redelivery, or when redelivery should have taken place; (2) if the passenger wishes to make any sort of claim against FOT or Star Clippers, the passenger must notify FOT directly in writing with a copy of the notification to the carrier or carriers responsible for actually performing the carriage and if asked to do so the passenger must assign all rights against such carrier or carriers to FOT.

Assistance
11.1 At FOT's sole discretion, FOT may afford or arrange assistance to any passenger who suffers illness, personal injury or death during the holiday. Such assistance may take the form of advice, guidance or initial financial aid where appropriate. Any expenses reasonably incurred for or on behalf of the passenger, either in this connection or otherwise in respect of matters that are not included in the holiday cost (including medical treatment and repatriation expenses) shall be repayable by the passenger to FOT in full on demand (whether or not the passenger has insurance cover for some or all of the expenses).

Material Facts

12.1. It is a condition of carriage that all material facts have been disclosed by the passenger to FOT as if FOT were an insurer. A material fact is a fact likely to influence insurers in the acceptance or assessment of insurance (for example, a matter relating to the state of health of the passenger or a close relative). Where there is doubt as to whether a fact is 'material' then it should be disclosed.

Mobility and Special Assistance

13.1. Passengers must give written notice to FOT at the time of Booking of any disability, mobility problem, or any other condition requiring special care, attention or treatment. If any such condition arises after Booking then written notice must be given to FOT as soon as possible. It may not be possible satisfactorily to accommodate a passenger with such a condition on board a Star Clippers vessel. Passage may therefore be refused to those with such a condition at the sole discretion of FOT or the operator.

13.2 Women who will be more than 28 weeks pregnant at the end of the holiday are not permitted to travel. The carriage of children or infants may be subject to a minimum age. Documentary and Medical Requirements

14.1. A full Valid passport is required for all holidays, valid for at least 6 months after the date of return to the UK. The passenger is responsible for ensuring compliance with all necessary visa and other documentary requirements for the entire holiday, and shall have received all medical inoculations necessary (notwithstanding that FOT may provide advice on these matters from time to time). Advice on these matters may be obtained from the Foreign, Commonwealth & Development Office. At any port or place FOT or any other party involved in the supply of services in connection with this contract may refuse travel or accommodation, or disembark any passenger without compensation who in the opinion of FOT or other party involved might be excluded from landing at any destination by Immigration or other Governmental Authorities or who may be suffering from contagious or infectious disease or whose presence may be considered detrimental to the safety or comfort of other holidaymakers or crew members.

Flights
15.1 This publication is the sole responsibility of FOT. It is not made on behalf of, and does not commit any airline mentioned or any other airline whose services are used during the course of the holiday. Notwithstanding this any rules, regulations, terms and conditions published by any such airline will apply.
15.2 Published prices for fly/cruises are inclusive of specially negotiated airfares which are subject to availability and may include an amount to cover flight disruption insurance. If no aircraft seats are available at such fares in conjunction with a particular cruise at the time of Booking then the fly/cruise option will not be offered. Flight upgrades/premium seats for fly/cruises are limited in number. They will be allocated at the time of Booking, subject to availability at the time of the cruise. Aircraft configurations are subject to change and in the event of a flight operator being unable to provide premium seats on any service then any payment of or towards an upgrade supplement will be refunded in full.
15.3 All published itineraries are based on current airline schedules. The passenger will be notified of any changes. Details of which aircraft operator will be used for the holiday booked and the type of aircraft operated cannot always be given at the time of Booking and may be subject to change.
15.4 If the Contract does not include flights, it is the Passenger's responsibility to obtain a valid ticket direct from an air carrier suitable for and in time for travel to the vessel (and including local transfers which the Passenger must arrange). FOT shall not be responsible for any liabilities arising in respect of flights or transfers arranged by the Passenger.

Marketing communications from FOT will allow the passenger the opportunity to opt out of further marketing communications. FOT will not disclose personal details to third parties for marketing purposes without express permission.

17.1 It is a requirement that travel insurance is taken out

liabilities for the holiday. Details must be provided on request
including during the holiday if required.

Law and Jurisdiction 20.1 These Conditions and any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with it or its subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims) shall be governed by and construed in accordance with English Law. 21.1 The parties irrevocable agree that the courts of England and Wales shall have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute or claim that arises out of or in connection with these Conditions or its subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims).
